**UI Problem that this pattern solves**

---

The user needs to be able to navigate up (backtrack toward the home page) and have an understanding of where he/she is in relation to the rest of the site.

**How it works**

---

A series of links are placed at the top of the page that reflect the categories and subcategories that contain the current page, allowing the user to 'move up a level' in the information sets. Typically, the current page is included as the last of the breadcrumb text but it is not linked.
